Mr Naveen Kumar is a consultant in spinal injuries at the Midland Centre for Spinal Injuries (MCSI), based at the Robert Jones & Agnes Hunt Orthopaedic Hospital, Oswestry, an internationally recognised centre of excellence for managing musculoskeletal disorders. He is also honorary consultant at University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust.

Mr Kumar qualified from Mysore University, India in 1998, and followed a surgical career, chiefly in trauma, orthopaedics and spine surgery. He pursued an interest in spinal cord injury (SCI), training in both the UK and USA between 2004 and 2010.

He has published several papers in peer reviewed journals, including the Lancet, on a variety of studies including randomised controlled trials and measures of outcome of SCIs.

Mr Kumar teaches Keele University medical students and also supervises post-graduate trainees from West Midlands Deanery. He is on the executive committees of the British Society of Rehabilitation Medicine (BSRM), the European Society of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and the International Spinal Cord Society.

He is also chair of BSRM's Spinal Cord Injury Medicine Special Interest Group.
