



THE WHEELCHAIR REFERRER ADVANCED PROGRAMME

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Summary:

The Wheelchair Referrer Advanced Programme (WRAP) was launched in December 2015 with the aim of identifying and authorising wheelchair referrers to request, prescribe and fit appropriate wheelchairs and accessories directly, without requiring assessment by the Posture & Mobility Service (PMS). Attendees were given Level 2 referrer accreditation.




Impact on PMS:

Comparison of time taken by clinical team to complete complex postural referrals




2. Cost effectiveness:




*81% of referrals made in 2016 by level 2 referrers resulted in direct order of equipment.

Where level 2 referrers are based:




Two places were offered to each LHB the South Wales PMS serves.
