Getting to the CIA could not be easier for visitors. Located in the heart of Cardiff, there are direct road routes from the M4 to the venue and the main coach and train stations are both within walking distance.

By Road

From M4 Westbound

Approach Cardiff on M4, leave at Junction 29 - Cardiff East and South. Continue on A48(M) until exit signed Cardiff and Docks A4232 - take this exit and stay in dedicated left lane. Follow signs to City Centre A4161. At next roundabout, turn right to City Centre under Flyover along Newport Road for 2 miles. Under Railway Bridge, turn left past Queen Street Railway Station to next set of traffic lights. The CIA is approx 75m to the left.

For rear access turn left, Security Lodge Entrance is on your right. For front access, take same left at lights then right at next lights and right again to bring you to the Front Entrance, opposite the Park Inn Hotel. There is no parking available at the front of the building and is only suitable for drop off and pick up.

Alternative Route from M4 (East or Westbound)

Leave M4 at Junction 33 - take A4232 - signs to Barry Island and Cardiff Docks. Carry on road for approximately 10 miles, go through tunnel and turn left at next roundabout. Bear right at next roundabout along the dual carriageway to traffic lights. Turn left at lights and keep in right hand lane, go under railway bridge and turn right at next set of lights - The CIA will be on your right opposite the Park Inn Hotel.

By Rail / Coach

Cardiff International Arena is 8 minutes walk from Cardiff Central Bus and Rail Stations

Paddington, London to Cardiff is just over 2 hours by Intercity, with trains departing hourly

Direct Rail and Coach services available from Liverpool, Manchester, Nottingham, Birmingham and the South East

By Air

Cardiff International Airport is 35 minutes by road from the City Centre with a regular Express Bus service and Taxis. Scheduled flights are available to and from the UK and many European Cities as well as Transatlantic services - see <http://www.tbicardiffairport.com> for more details.
