1. Proposer's name, place of work and contact email address
2. Name of nominee(s), their place of work and contact email address
3. Description of the work to be considered for the award [250 words max]
4. Brief details of the achievements of the work within the following categories [50 words max each]
 - a. Impact
 - b. Innovation
 - c. Reach
 - d. Cost
 - e. Repeatability
